**NOTICE OF THE QUALIFYING EXAMINATION FOR ENROLMENT OF VETERINARY
PARAPROFESSIONALS TO BE HELD ON 14TH AND 15TH SEPTEMBER, 2026**

The Veterinary Council of Tanzania (VCT) hereby informs all eligible Veterinary Paraprofessionals who wish to be enrolled under the provisions of the Veterinary Act that the **Qualifying Examination for Enrolment of Veterinary Paraprofessionals** will be conducted on **14th and 15th September, 2026**.

This Notice is issued pursuant to Section 5(2)(I) of the Veterinary Act, CAP. 319 (R.E. 2023) which mandates the Council to arrange and conduct qualifying examinations to establish competence in Veterinary Education and practice, read together with the Veterinary (Procedures for Registration Examinations for Veterinarians and Veterinary Specialists) Regulations, 2005, as amended by the Veterinary (Procedures for Registration Examinations for Veterinarians and Veterinary Specialists) (Amendment) Regulations, 2016.

The Qualifying Examination shall be conducted at the following designated examination centres located at Livestock Training Agency (LITA) Campuses in Mainland Tanzania:

1. LITA Tengeru
2. LITA Buhuri
3. LITA Temeke
4. LITA Morogoro
5. LITA Mpwapwa
6. LITA Madaba
7. LITA Mabuki

Application Procedure

Eligible candidates are required to submit their applications electronically through the **Mifugo Integrated Management Information System (MIMIS)**, accessible at:

<http://mimis.mifugo.go.tz>

Upon successful submission of the application, the system will automatically generate a control number through which the prescribed examination fee shall be paid in accordance with the Veterinary Council (Fees and Charges) Regulations, 2015.

Applicants are advised to ensure that all required information and supporting documents are accurately and completely uploaded through the MIMIS before the application deadline. In particular, applicants must ensure that their names and other personal particulars are entered exactly as they appear on their academic certificates and other official identification documents. The Council shall not be responsible for any inconvenience arising from incorrect or incomplete information provided during the application process.

Eligibility to sit for the Qualifying Examination shall be restricted to applicants who meet the eligibility requirements prescribed under the Veterinary Act, CAP. 319 (R.E. 2023), and the relevant Regulations, have successfully completed the online application through the MIMIS, and have paid the prescribed examination fee within the stipulated application period.

The Council reserves the right to reject any application that does not comply with the requirements prescribed under the Veterinary Act, the applicable Regulations, or this Notice.

Applicants are required to regularly visit the official website of the Veterinary Council of Tanzania (VCT) for all official communications relating to the Qualifying Examination. Such communications shall include, but not be limited to, the examination timetable, the list of eligible candidates admitted to sit for the examination, instructions to candidates, examination centres, and the release of examination results.

Applicants requiring clarification on any matter relating to the examination may contact the Council through its official office telephone numbers **+255 738 144 839** or **+255 738 144 841** during normal working hours, from **7:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m., Monday to Friday (Excluding Public Holidays)**.

The Council shall not be responsible for any inconvenience arising from an applicant's failure to access information published on its official VCT website or to seek clarification through the official communication channels within the stipulated working hours.

Closing Date

The deadline for submission of applications is **30th August, 2026**. Applications received after the closing date shall **not** be considered.
